

Health Vertical Indigenous Scholarship 2018

Description of discount: Discount for 1 Indigenous student per intake to be selected via a competitive application process and managed through Marketing.

Eligibility criteria: This scholarship must be awarded to an Indigenous student who is recognised as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander. Applicable to students applying for any course within the Health Vertical across THINK or TUA.

Terms and conditions:

The scholarship award depends on the assessment by the Marketing team.

Discount applicable on tuition fee only and on first attempt subjects only. Full price should be charged on other fees and retake subjects.

% of discount: 20% scholarship will cover 1 year of tuition fees for Diploma and Bachelor Degrees OR 1 trimester of tuition fees for Master, Diploma and Graduate Diploma courses.

Effective Trimester: T1, 2018

End Date: 31 December 2018

The scholarship recipient must meet all entry requirements of the course and have submitted a course application form.

By accepting the scholarship the recipient must agree to take part in marketing activities and college events (such as Open Days, Information Evenings, Workshops etc), contribute to the college's social media channels and provide testimonials as required.

Scholarships are for new, full-time students only. The recipient will be required to commence studies in the intake in which they enrol in.

Deferral or withdrawal of studies will result in forfeit of the remainder of the scholarship award (or the entire award if the studies have not yet commenced).

Should a scholarship recipient intend to transition to part-time mode at any point during their studies, the vertical reserves the right to discontinue the scholarship award.

The scholarship recipient is expected to excel academically, and their performance will be monitored each study period. A failure to meet academic obligations may result in forfeit of the scholarship award. Subsequent fees for repeating a failed subject will be the responsibility of the student.

Scholarship award is attributable for Diplomas and Bachelor Degrees as a fee credit for the first year of study only and is non-transferable.

Scholarship award is attributable for Master, Diploma and Graduate Diploma courses as a fee credit for the first trimester of study only and is non-transferable.

At the discretion of college administration, scholarships can and may be split and awarded as partial value or not awarded at all, depending on the overall quality of submissions.
